In spring of 1996, Mrs. Vivian Y. G. Fu (the 9th NATWA President) decided to set up a scholarship fund in memory of her late husband, Dr. Kwung-Ping Fu. Four \$500 scholarships will be awarded annually to encourage young Taiwanese Americans to participate in public affair. Taiwanese American students in their high school senior year or undergraduate years in college are qualified to apply. Applicants should demonstrate an interest in and understanding of their heritage by completing an internship (for at least 3 weeks) in a non-profit Taiwanese American Organization with an established internship program.

Application deadline for scholarship are March 15 and 9/15 of each year. Applicants should fill out the application form and send it with all the supporting documents to:

- Two letters of recommendation
- An essay on what you would like to accomplish during the internship
- A confirmation letter from the sponsoring organization stating internship duration
