



North America Taiwanese Women's Association Internship Program 2006-2007

North America Taiwanese Women's Association (NATWA) was founded in Los Angeles in 1988 as a non-profit organization. To learn more about NATWA, please visit our website at www.natwa.com. In 2002, the NATWA Board passed an initiative to recruit members from younger generations to form "NATWA II." The purposes for establishing NATWA II are as follows:

1. To establish a network- and support-based group consisting of young Taiwanese American and Canadian women.
2. To create a database for young Taiwanese American and Canadian female professionals.
3. To embrace and cultivate various talents of young Taiwanese American and Canadian women.

The objective of this internship program for NATWA II is to help develop the technical, communications, and organizational capacity for the NATWA II program.

Candidate qualification:

To apply, candidates should meet the following requirements:

1. Second or one and half Taiwanese American/Canadian Women in or post college study.
2. Recommended by NATWA Chapters or board members or NATWA ally organization

Appointment and Duties:

1. This is a twelve-month (April 2006 to March 2007), part-time appointment. During the term, the intern will commit at least 8 hours per quarter on her own schedule to help the NATWA II Committee.
2. Under the leadership of the NATWA II Committee Chair, the intern will assist in organizational planning, member recruitment, and program development.
3. The intern will take the lead in developing a website for NATWA II and other communication systems for NATWA II (ideas include a listserv, discussion forums, or a newsletter).
4. The intern is required to attend the NATWA Convention April 13-16, 2006, to assist in the Taiwanese American Women Film Festival and other NATWA II activities at the convention. Participation in the Oct. 2006 mid-year meeting is optional. Food and board at these meetings are covered by NATWA.
5. Progress and final reports from the intern to the NATWA president are due on 9/30/2006 and 3/31/2007, respectively.
6. The intern will participate in the quarterly Committee conference call meetings to discuss important matters and resolutions needed to move the committee forward.

Stipend:

US\$1,000 (\$500 on April 16, 2006 and \$500 on October 30, 2006)
